PRIVACY POLICY

1. WE RESPECT YOUR PRIVACY

We respect your right to privacy and this policy sets out how we collect and treat your personal information.

2. WHAT PERSONAL INFORMATION WE COLLECT

We may collect the following types of personal information from you:

name

address

email address

phone number

information submitted as part of relevant safe ministry checks

communications between us

3. HOW WE COLLECT YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION

We collect personal information from you in a variety of ways, including: when you interact with us electronically or in person; when you access our website or social media presence(s); and when we provide our services to you.

4. USE OF YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION

We use your information to provide our service(s) to you. We also use it to improve our service and to notify you of opportunities that we think you might be interested in.

We do not provide your information to third parties, except that we may provide your information to our business partners who assist us in the provision of our services to you.

We will not under any circumstances sell or rent your information to a third party.

5. SECURITY OF YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION

We take reasonable steps to protect your personal information, including limiting access to staff or authorised volunteers for the purposes of leading ministry teams. We give training to all who handle personal information of the need for care with how it is handled. However we are not liable for any unauthorised access to this information.
